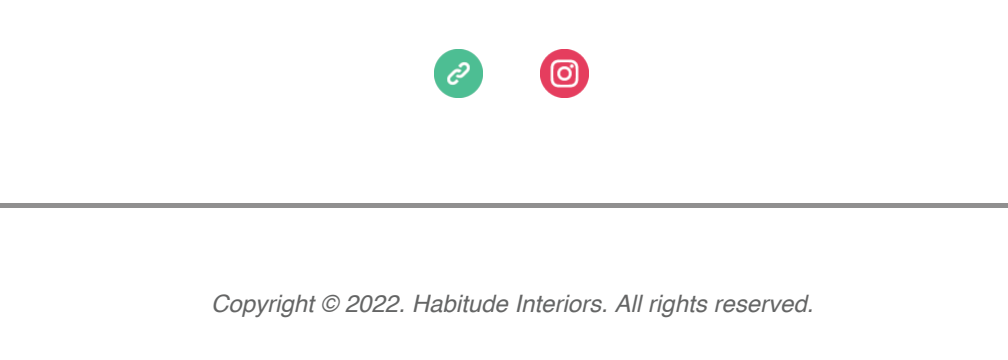
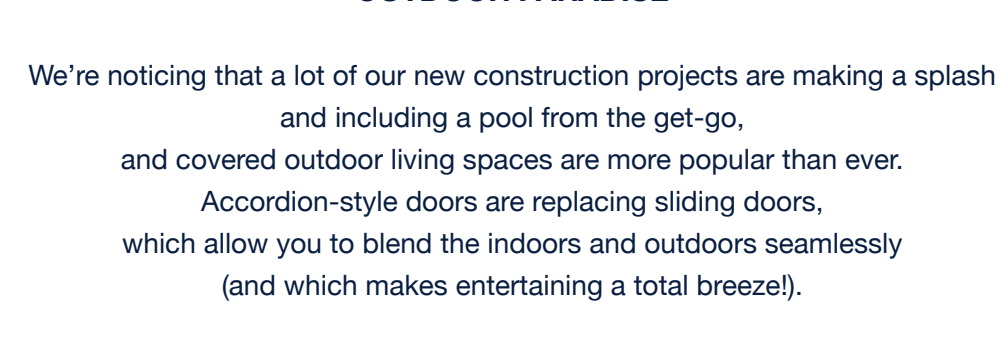
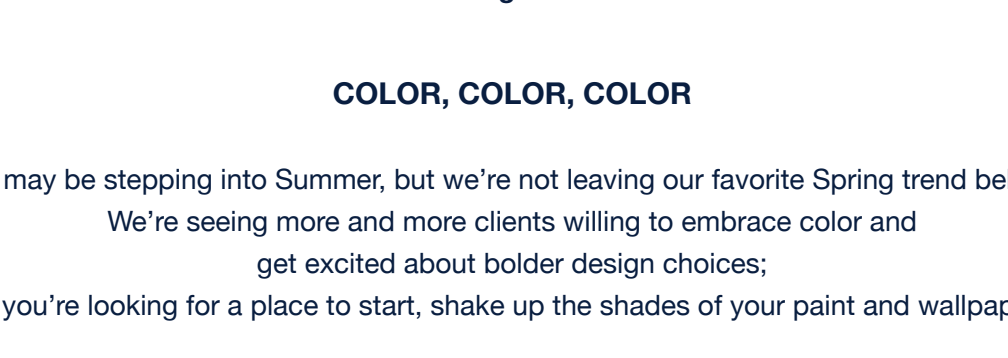
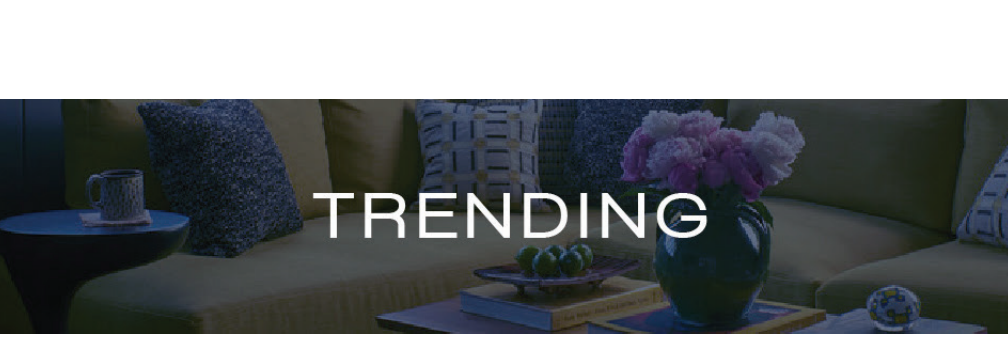
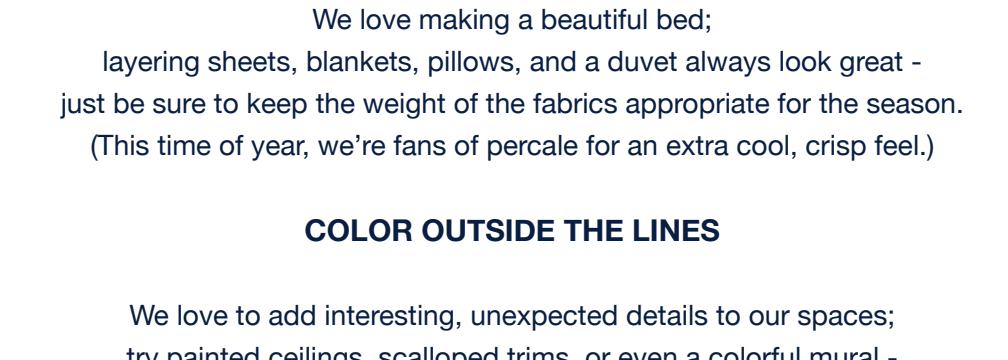
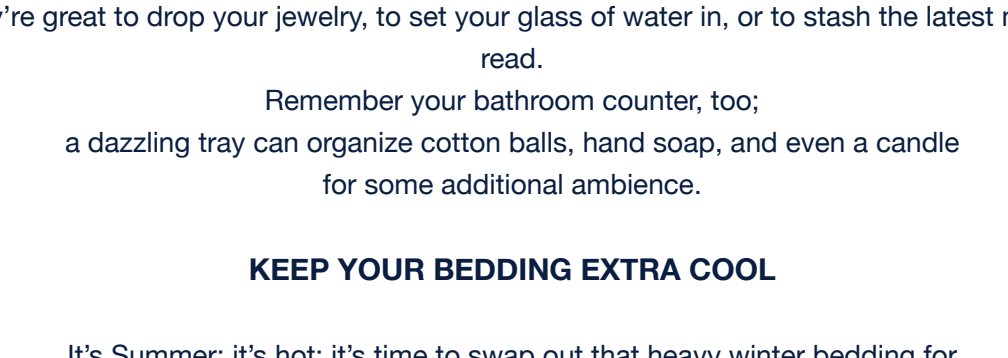
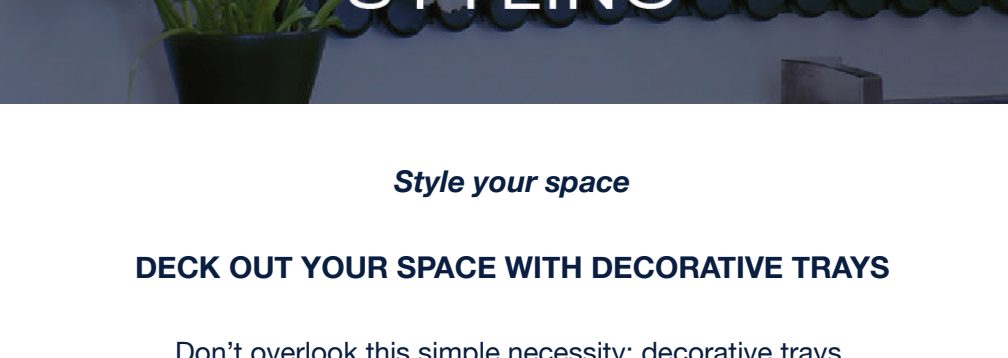
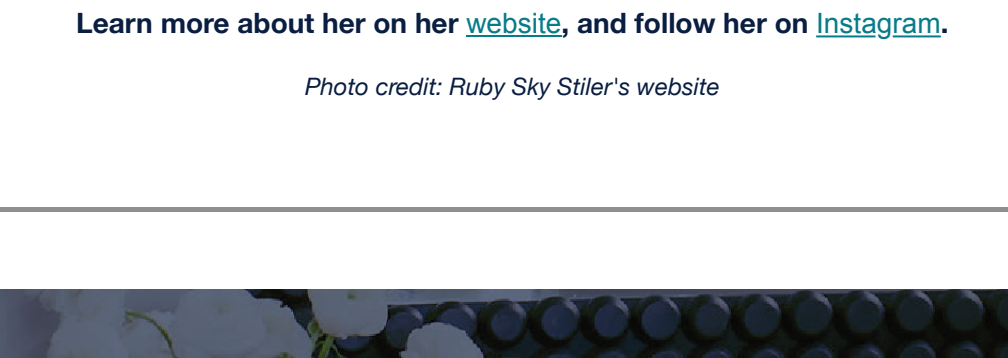
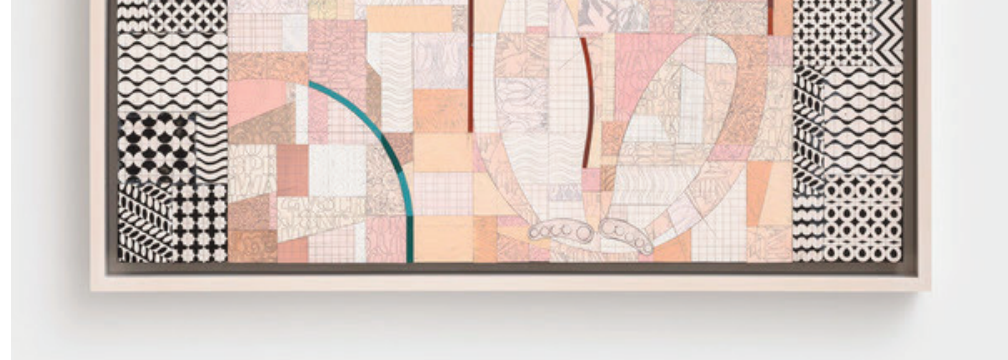
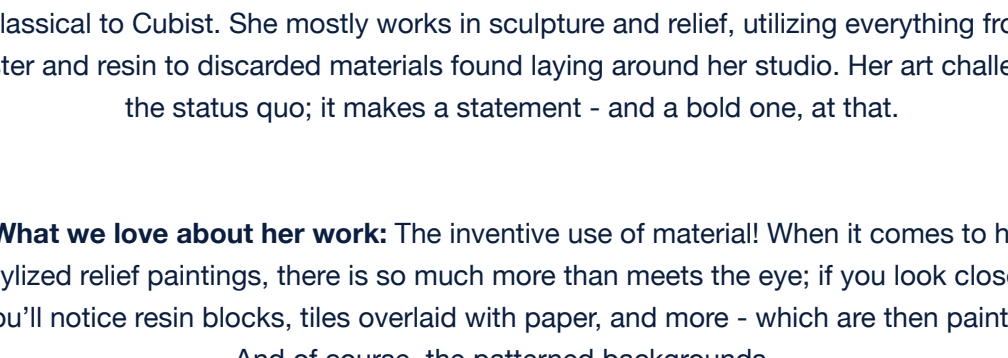
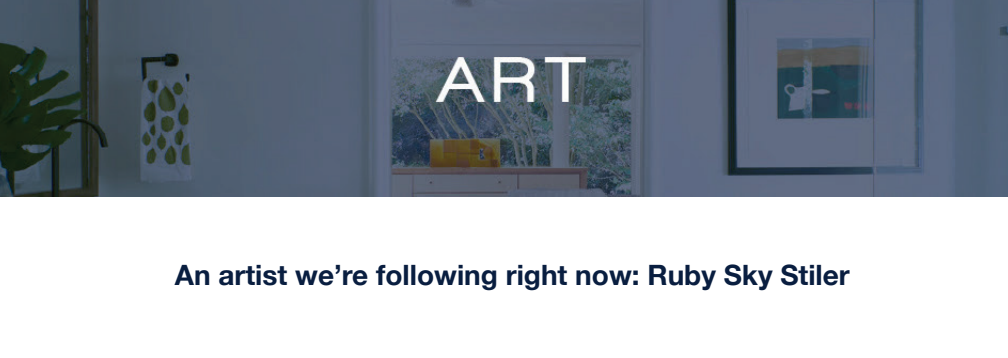
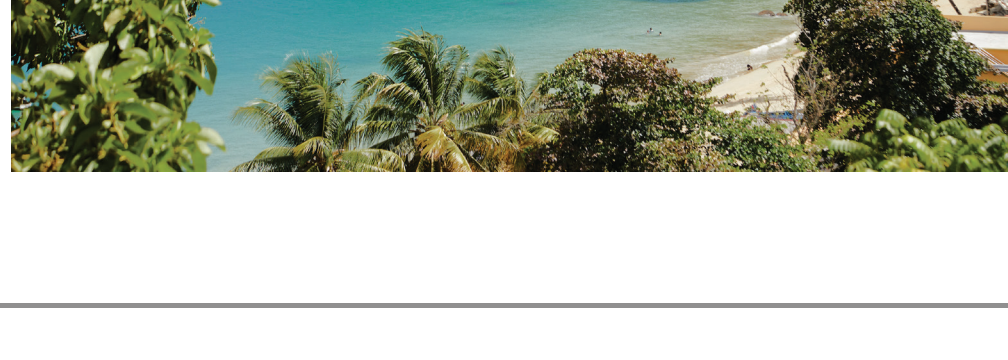
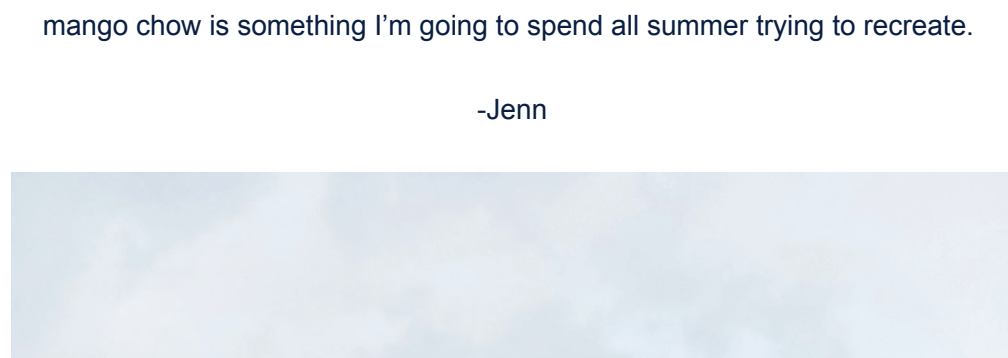
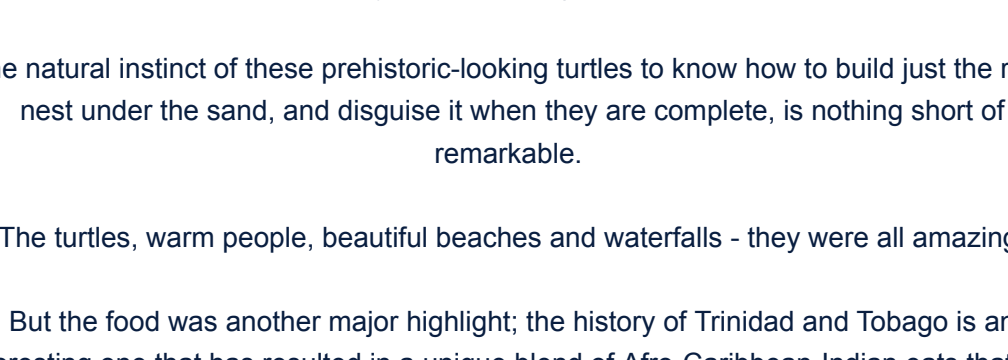
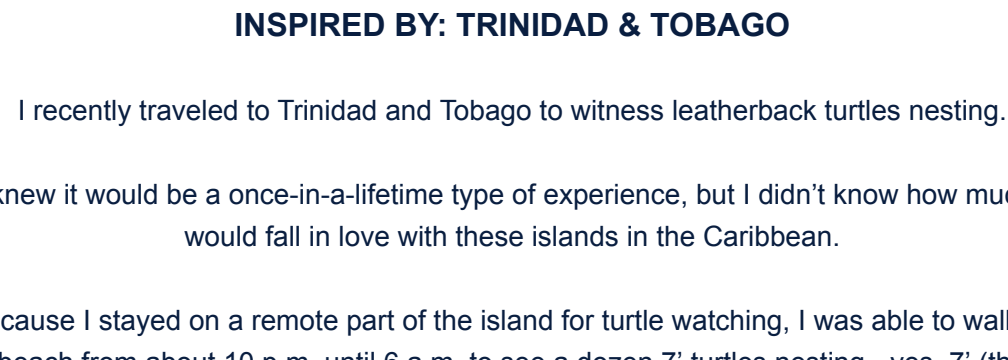
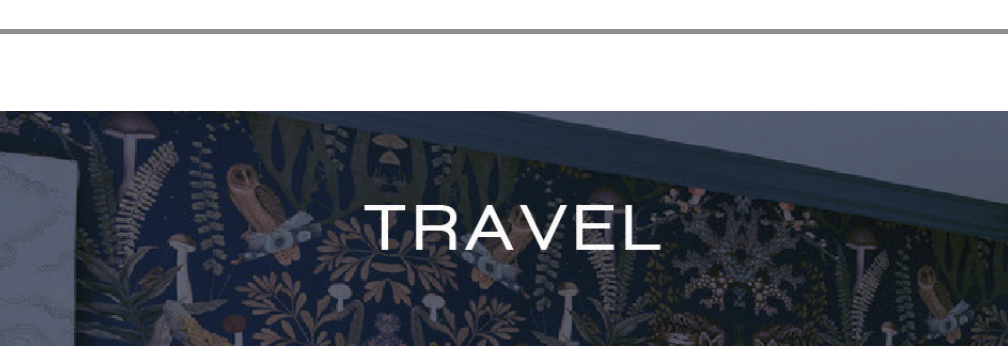
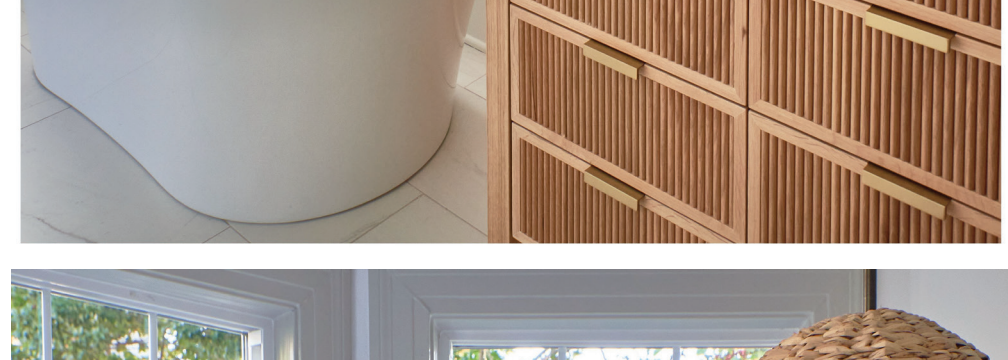
## PROJECTS

I knew it would be a once-in-a-lifetime type of experience, but I didn't know how much I would fall in love with these islands in the Caribbean.

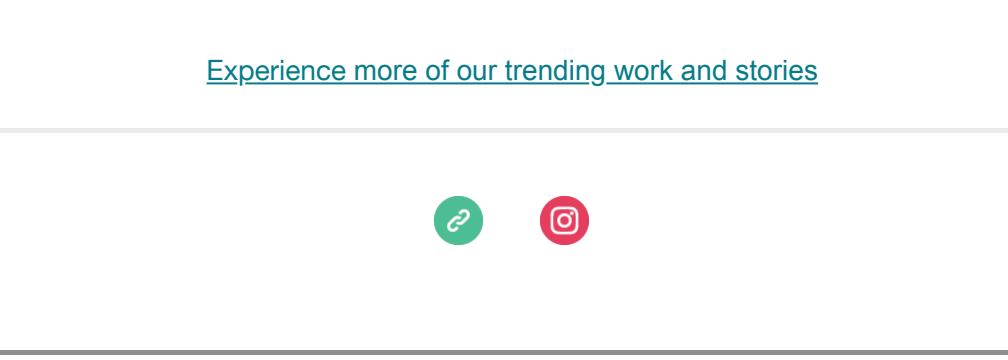
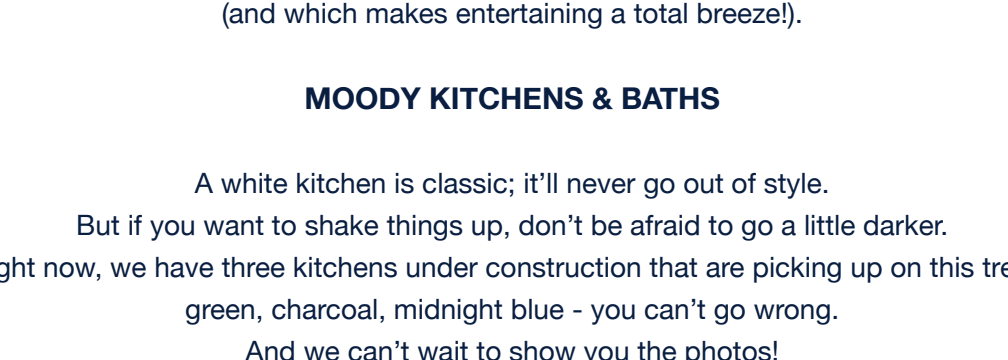
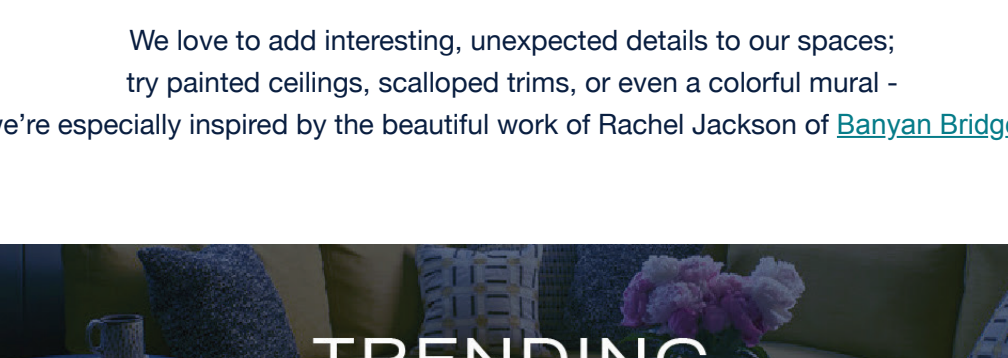
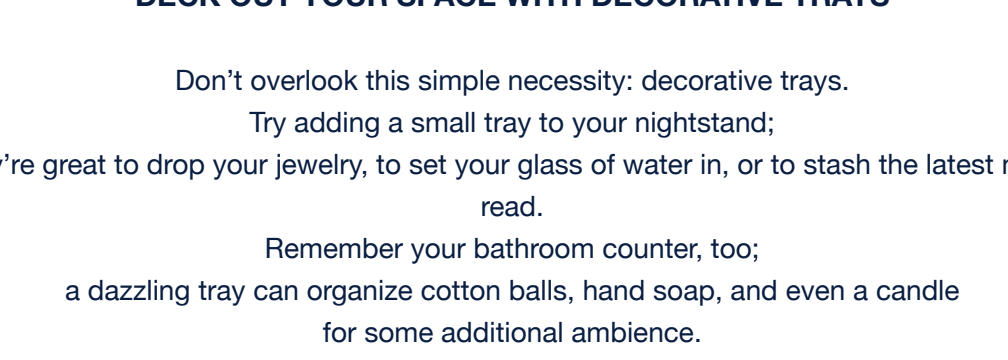
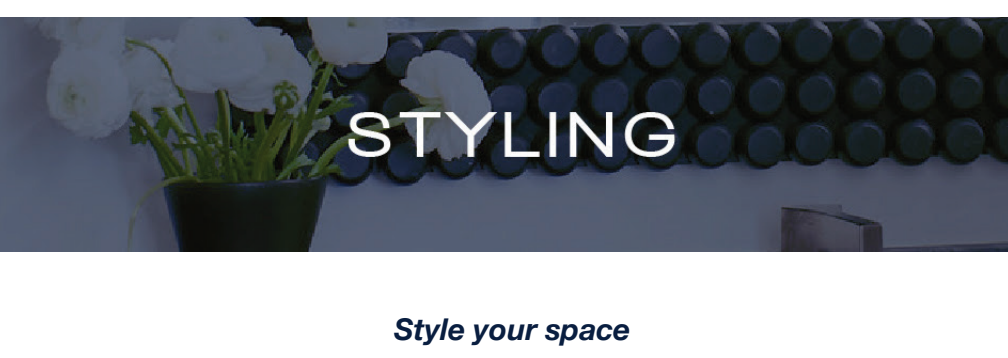
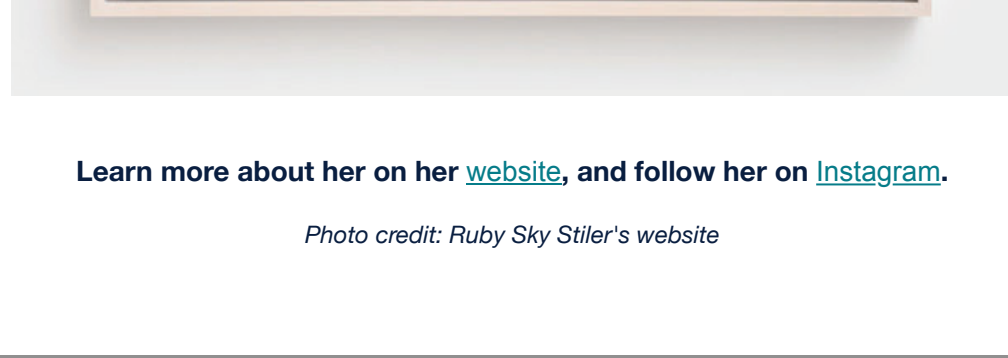
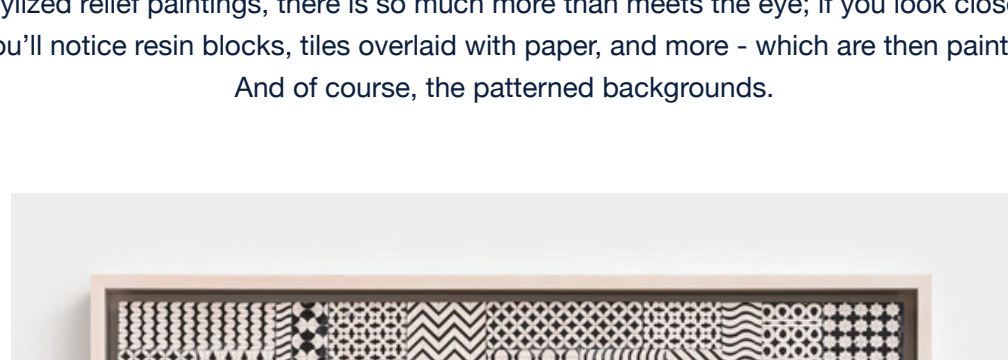
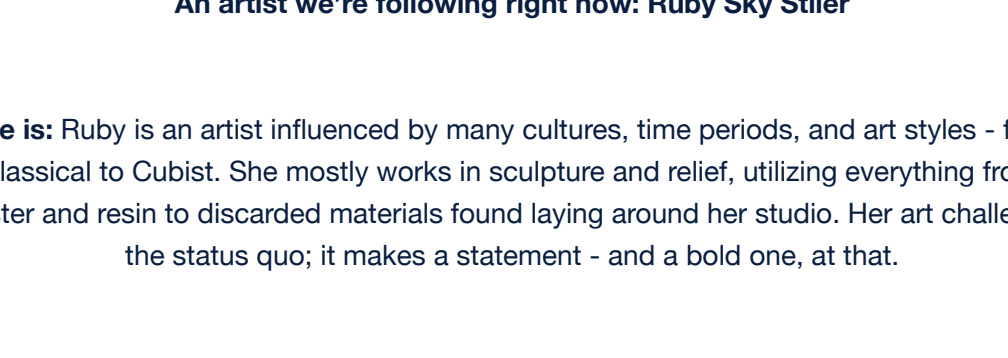
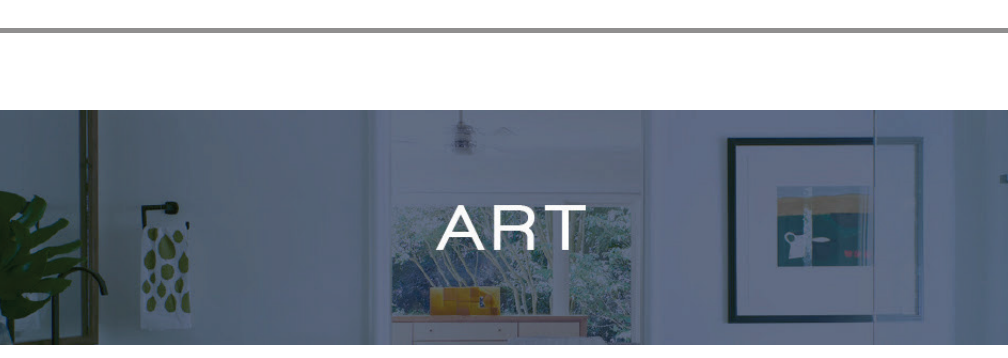

The natural instinct of these prehistoric-looking turtles to know how to build just the right nest under the sand, and disguise it when they are complete, is nothing short of remarkable.

The turtles, warm people, beautiful beaches and waterfalls - they were all amazing.

But the food was another major highlight; the history of Trinidad and Tobago is an interesting one that has resulted in a unique blend of Afro-Caribbean-Indian eats that are out of this world. 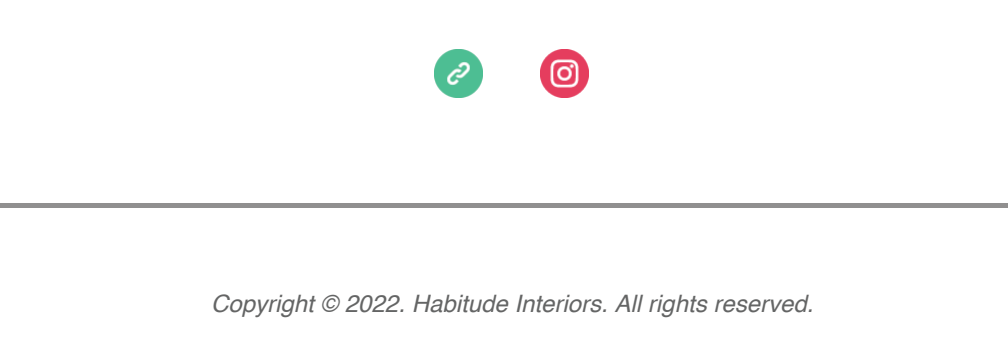
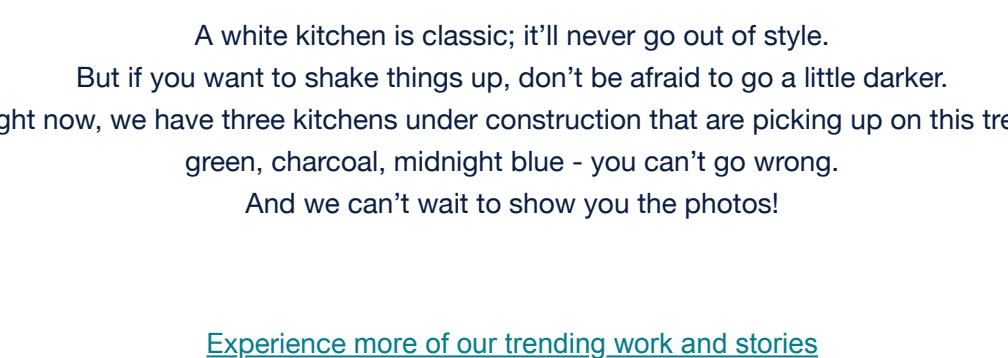
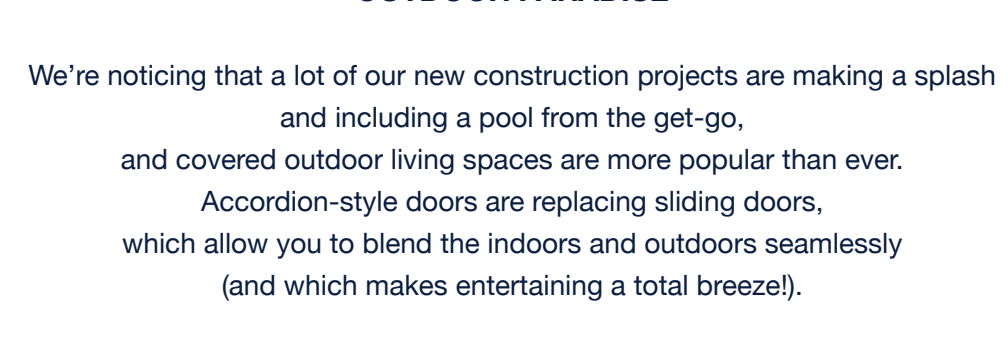
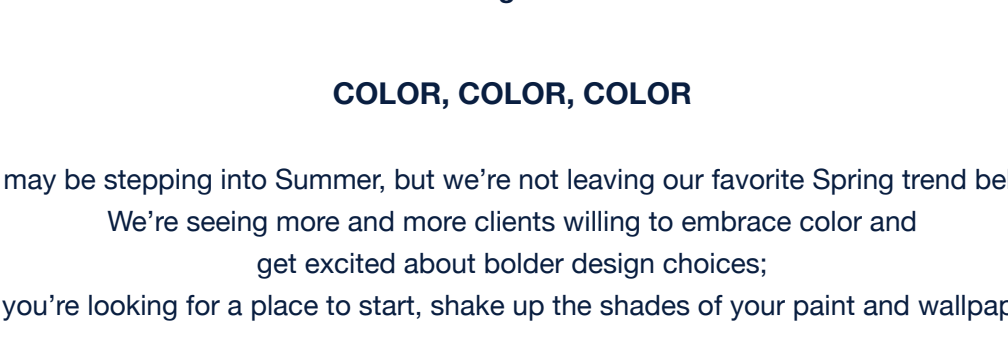
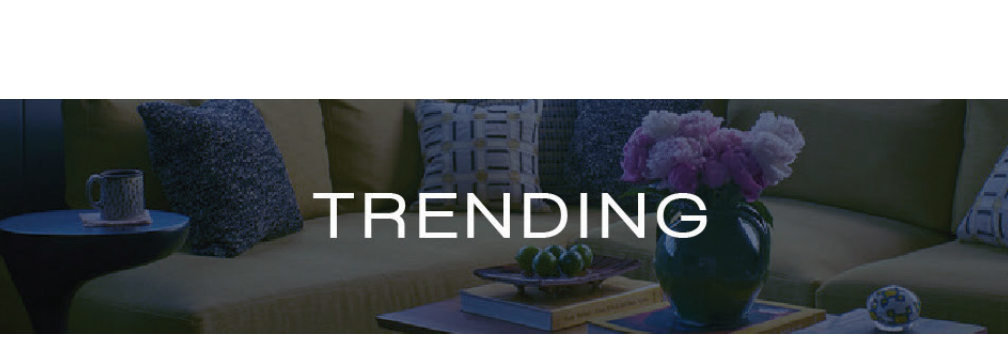
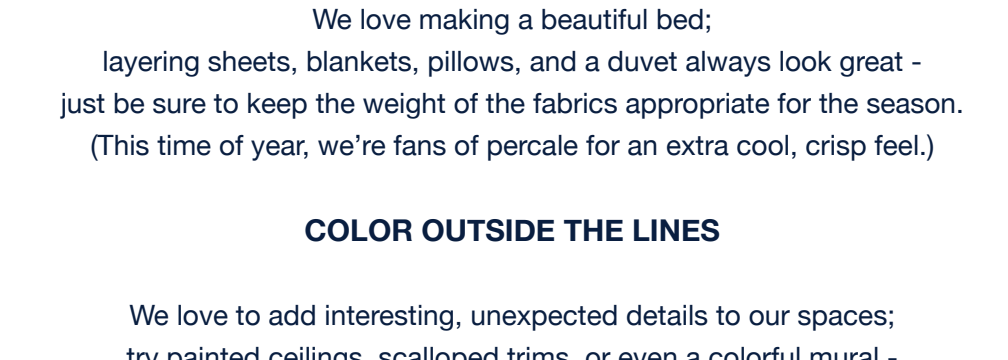
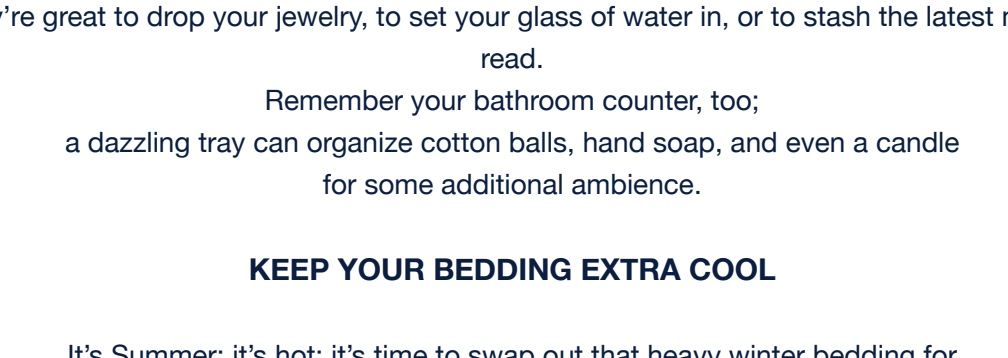
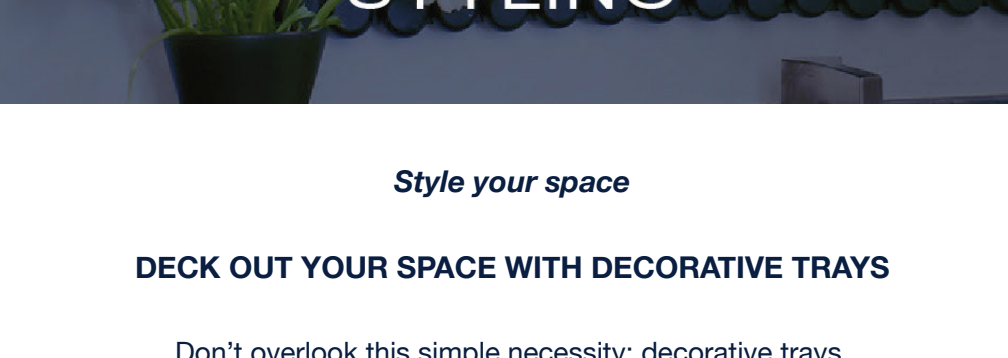
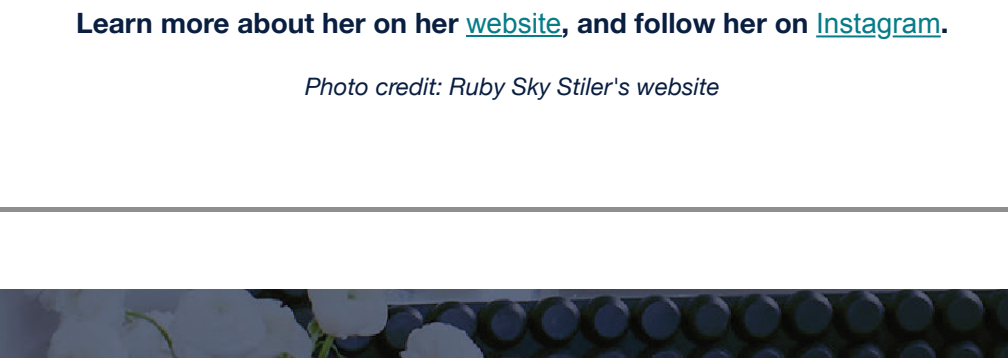


## ART
